1. BACKGROUND

- 1.1. The Northern Territory Clay Target Association Inc (NTCTA) has formulated this policy to secure a safe and health sporting environment for all State Team Members participants ('STMs') and attendees.
- 1.2. This policy aims to ensure that adequate uniforms are provided to all STMs so as to identify such members representing or acting on behalf of the NTCTA at National Events, Carnivals and/or Titles ('Nationals').
- 1.3. This policy is only applicable to STMs who are selected by the NTCTA to represent the NTCTA at Nationals.

2. THE UNIFORM

- 2.1. The NTCTA will provide the following NTCTA approved uniform items to the selected STM's:
 - (a) A hat;
 - (b) A shirt;
 - (c) A shooting jacket; and
 - (d) A hand towel.
- 2.2. In the event that Nationals are held in winter, the NTCTA will also provide the selected STM's with a jacket (in addition to a shooting jacket).
- 2.3. When competing at Nationals, the STM's must provide at their own expense:
 - (a) Black shoes (both males and females);
 - (b) Full length black dress pants (males);
 - (c) Full length black dress pants <u>OR</u> knee length dress skirt (females).

3. SHOOTING JACKETS

- 3.1. Due to the expense of shooting jackets, the NTCTA will only provide new shooting jackets to STM's:
 - (a) Every three (3) years; and/or
 - (b) If the design of the shooting jacket changes (as approved by the NTCTA).
- 3.2. Shooting jackets are only permitted to be worn by STM's at National and State events.
- 3.3. In the event the shooting jacket is deemed to be in poor condition at the discretion of the NTCTA (i.e. stained, tattered), it is the STM's sole responsibility and expense to obtain a replacement shooting jacket.
