1. BACKGROUND

- 1.1. The Northern Territory Clay Target Association (**NTCTA**) is committed to providing an environment that is safe while participating in the sport of clay target shooting.
- 1.2. The ACTA provides suspension clauses for the safety of members that are attending at a clay target facility/club, namely clause 1.01 as detailed below:

1.01 SAFETY

(d) Firing the gun in any position other than orthodox, ie to the shoulder, is prohibited (with the exception of a physical disability). Any shooter firing a gun from any position other than orthodox will be immediately suspended by the Club Management and reported in writing to the Executive Committee – a minimum penalty of three months suspension shall apply.

(k) Any shooter knowingly breaching any safety rule other than 1.01(d), will be immediately suspended by the club management for one (1) calendar month pending an investigation into their actions by the relevant State Association and the ACTA must be notified of all breaches and responses.

(l) Any shooter committing an ungentlemanly or unsafe act on the shooting ground shall be liable to suspension or disqualification.

2. POLICY

- 2.1. Any breaches of the above listed safety rules require action to be taken by both the Club Management and NTCTA Executive Council.
- 2.2. All clubs affiliated with the NTCTA will ensure that all rules as detailed in the "Australian Clay Target Association – Shooting Rules" are adhered to.
- 2.3. Any action required pursuant to Rule 1.01 regarding the suspension of members and the reporting of breaches must be undertaken immediately upon the infringement occurring.
- 2.4. Once the infringement has been reported to the NTCTA Executive Council, the Secretary shall take all steps necessary for the investigation of the reported breach and/or suspension.
- 2.5. This policy should be read in conjunction with the Shooting Rules of the ACTA.
